



## Seven camps of Psychology

1. Your group is to set up a "camp" that represents your assigned perspective.  
Assignment: \_\_\_\_\_
2. Goal: A person should be able to understand your perspective just by the "camping" equipment they find at your camp.
3. You will have three minutes to explain your "equipment" to the class. The equipment must meet the criteria of your perspective.
4. Examples:
  - a. MRI picture or a mock up of one should be at a camp representing Biopsychological perspective
  - b. Memory test representing cognitive perspective.
  - c. Picture of Freud for psychoanalytical perspective.
5. Requirements/Rubric:
  - a. At least six items needed to represent your perspective for a C grade.
  - b. Must pertain to the perspective. If you cannot explain a rational reason for the equipment scrap it.
  - c. All members of the group can intelligently explain the camp site.
