Student Laptop Usage Agreement

The district network is provided for students to conduct research and communicate with others. Access to network services is given to students who agree to act in a considerate and responsible manner. Signatures are required from students on the Laptop Student User Agreement Form.

It is expected that users will comply with district standards and will honor the agreements they have signed. Beyond the clarification of such standards, the district is not responsible for restricting, monitoring, or controlling the communications of individuals utilizing the network.

Acceptable uses of the Paradise Valley Unified School District electronic information resources include:

- 1) Being responsible, courteous and polite.
- 2) Using appropriate language.
- 3) Honoring all rules and laws of copyright and personal property.
- 4) Accepting full responsibility for the use of personal accounts.
- 5) Researching assigned classroom projects.
- 6) Sending and receiving electronic mail (email).
- 7) Exploring other authorized computer systems, libraries, and databases, and bulletin boards.

Network storage areas may be treated like school lockers. Network administrators may review files and communications to maintain system integrity and insure that users are using the system responsibly. Users should not expect that files stored on district servers will be private.

Unacceptable uses of the Paradise Valley Unified District electronic information resources include:

- 1) Using obscene language.
- 2) Harassing, insulting or attacking others.
- 3) Damaging computers, computer systems or computer networks.
- 4) Sending or receiving copyrighted materials without permission.
- 5) Sending or displaying offensive messages or pictures.
- 6) Using another's password.
- 7) Trespassing in another's folders, work, or files.
- 8) Intentionally wasting limited resources.
- 9) Employing the network for commercial purposes.
- 10) Advertising or promoting events that are illegal or against school policy.
- 11) Using another student's laptop
